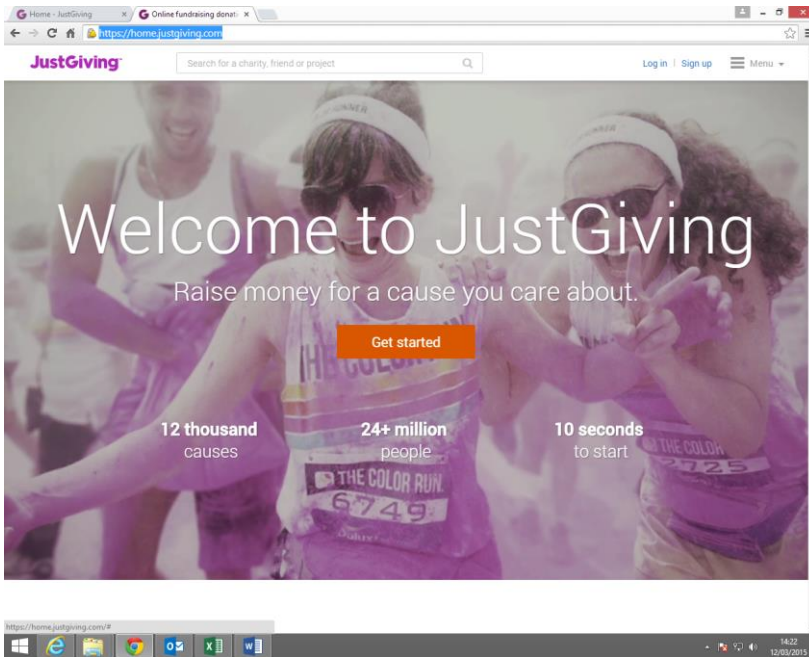
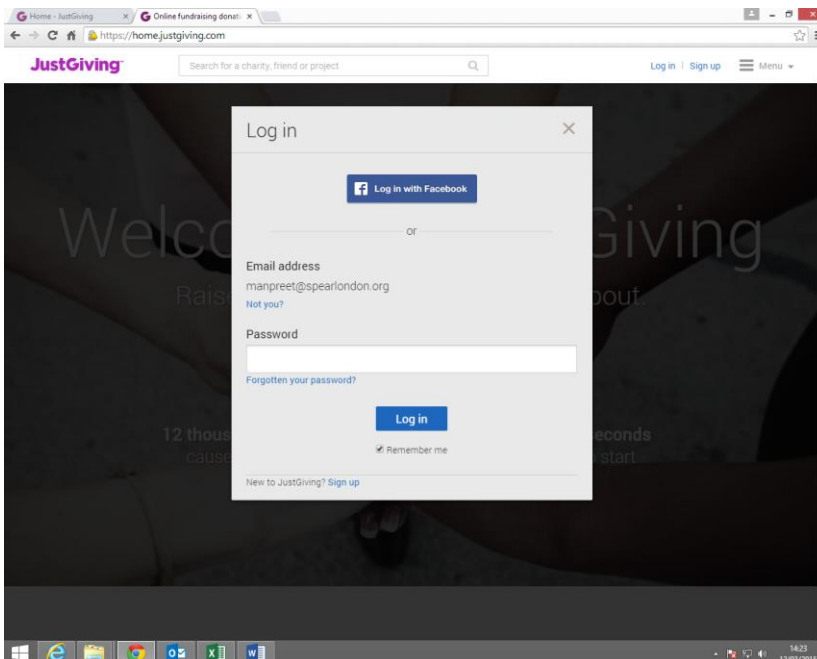

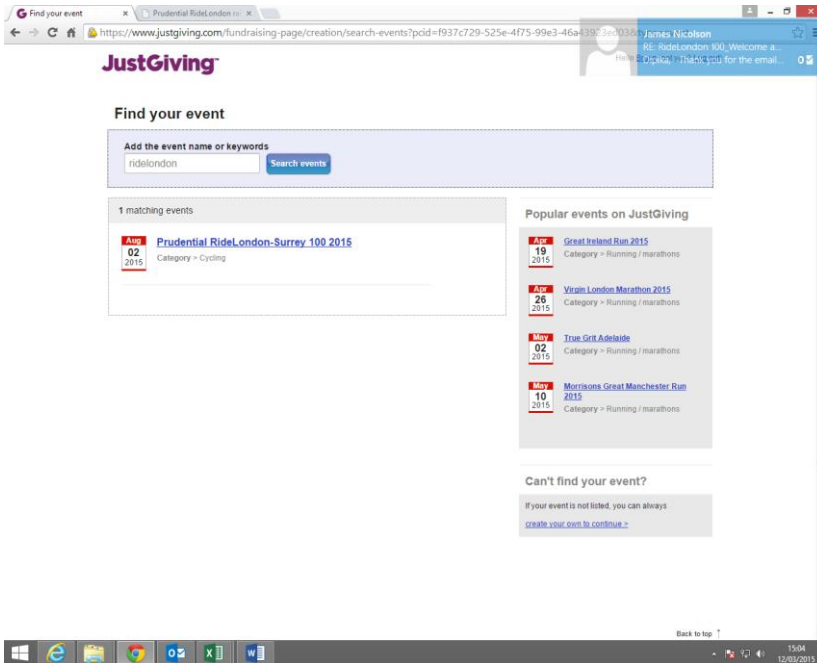
## Click on Start Fundraising

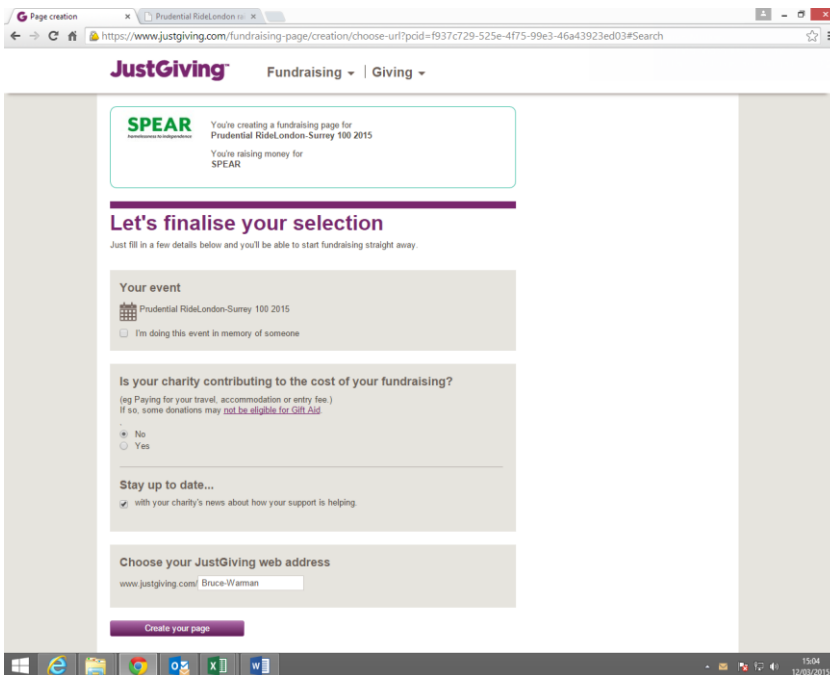
